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Welcome to the Youth Ambassadors of Non-Formal Learning 2 Ist Newsletter!


Youth Ambassadors of Non-Formal Learning 2 (YAMNFL2), co-funded by the Erasmus+ programme, supports youth in Europe and the Western Balkans through non-formal learning (NFL).

Launched in January 2024, the project emphasizes the importance of non-formal education by focusing on recognizing and validating skills acquired beyond traditional classroom settings. It aims to expand a network of Youth Ambassadors to boost employability and promote alternative career pathways in line with EU policies.

This two-year project, led by <u>LDA Mosta</u>r (Bosnia and Herzegovina), involves six partners: <u>TDM 2000</u> (Italy), <u>ADP-ZID</u> (Montenegro), <u>Youth4Society</u> (Albania), <u>USB</u> (Greece), and <u>NGO Iuventa</u> (Serbia).

KICK OFF OF THE PROJECT, TIRANA

The project officially started in Tirana, Albania, where partners planned the twoyear roadmap to promote NFL in Europe and the Western Balkans.



This methodology encourages collaboration, hands-on learning, and out-of-the-box thinking, making it a valuable tool for youth workers to equip participants with essential problem-solving skills for their personal and professional growth.



YAMNFL2 TRAINING PACKAGE





The YAMNFL2 Training Package is a comprehensive toolkit designed to empower youth workers and educators, in supporting youth (self-)employment. The training focuses on four key pillars mentioned in the graphic above.

The structure is flexible, allowing facilitators to adapt workshops to the needs of their participants or use them independently.
